# Digital Literacy: Using Film Making to Support Cross Curricular Teaching

## Course Outline

This course is designed to introduce Teachers and TAs to aspects of the Computing curriculum, focusing on one strand, Digital Literacy: Film Making. What is 'digital literacy'? What are the main features? Why should we teach it? Why should we teach children about safety online? We will explore these themes through some practical activities.

Delegates engage in a teamwork activity planning and filming a 2 minute film or Photostory, using iPads or digital cameras. We explore the use of iMovie in a non-technical way or Windows Movie Maker or Photostage Creator (free) on PC to create the film footage.
