Course Outline

Alternative and Augmentative Communication (AAC) Systems are essential for children and adults who find using speech and language skills a challenge. This course will look at what is AAC, assessment, unaided communication, low tech communication aids, and high tech communication aids. The course uses relevant teaching methods including practical activities, videos and group discussion to engage learners. The course is taught over 2 days and participants will need to submit a portfolio of evidence for assessment.
