Course Outline

This one-day course covers safe moving and handling of people, manual handling and safe use of equipment

Back problems account for one-third of all workers' absence in the UK. Training staff to handle objects and people safely can reduce the risk of injury and absence. The course will cover: what manual handling is, lifting and handling safely, avoiding musculo-skeletal injuries, understanding safer handling policies and procedures, and understanding the importance of team handling and communication.
